- Prevention and Education

Gabby Nixdorf provided updates on the work of the Prevention and Education Subcommittee and the three strategies developed by participants in the last 10 months. The Subcommittee will have the opportunity to meet again on July 1<sup>st</sup> to discuss the draft strategic plan, mission, and vision developed by the Community Services Department.

- Treatment and Recovery

Marsha Martino discussed some struggles in terms of meeting attendance for this specific subcommittee and her efforts to revitalize membership through sending out discussion questions for participants to respond to that can be incorporated into the subcommittee's current draft plan.
